Reach People, Teach People, and Minister to People.

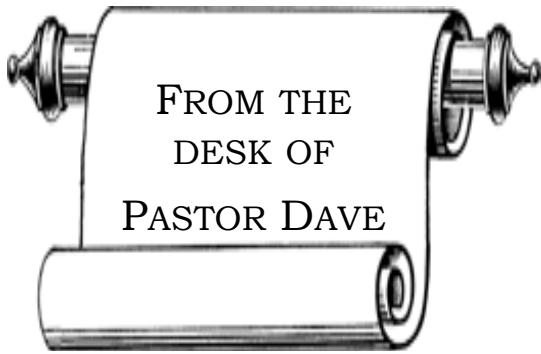
